


The Plumb Line— Show #2 Study Notes By: Sue Patterson 12th day of the 9th month November 14th, 2005



AM 7:7,8 Thus he showed me: and, behold, the Lord stood upon a wall made by a plumbline, with a plumbline in his hand. [8] And the LORD said unto me, Amos, what seest thou? And I said, A plumbline. Then said the Lord, Behold, I will set a plumbline in the midst of my people Israel: I will not again pass by them any more:

Wall #2346 - fem. act. particle of an unused root apparently meaning to join; a wall of protection: - wall, walled.

ISA 28:15-22 Because ye have said, We have made a covenant with death, and with hell are we at agreement; when the overflowing scourge shall pass through, it shall not come unto us: for we

have made lies our refuge, and under falsehood have we hid ourselves: [16] Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD, Behold, I lay in Zion for a foundation a stone, a tried stone, a precious corner stone, a sure foundation: he that believeth shall not make haste. [17] Judgment also will I lay to the line, and righteousness to the plummet: and the hail shall sweep away the refuge of lies, and the waters shall overflow the hiding place. [18] And

your covenant with death shall be disannulled, and your agreement with hell shall not stand; when the overflowing scourge shall pass through, then ye shall be trodden down by it. [19] From the time that it goeth forth it shall take you: for morning by morning shall it pass over, by day and by night: and it shall be a vexation only to understand the report. [20] For the bed is shorter than that a man can stretch himself on it: and the covering narrower than that he can wrap himself in it. [21] For the LORD shall rise up as in mount Perazim, he shall be wroth as in the valley of Gibeon that he may do his work, his strange work; and bring to pass his act, his strange act. [22] Now therefore be ye not mockers, lest your bands be made strong: for I have heard from the Lord GOD of hosts a consumption, even determined upon the whole earth. — "The LORD'S Strange Act"

Consumption #3617 from 3615: a completion; adv. Completely; also destruction.....

#3615 - a prim. root: to end, whether intrans. (To cease, be finished, perish) or trans. (To complete, prepare, consume)....

JER 33:14-16 Behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that I will perform that good thing which I have promised unto the house of Israel and to the house of Judah. [15] In those days, and at that time, will I cause the Branch of righteousness to grow up unto David; and he shall execute judgment and righteousness in the land. [16] In those days shall Judah be saved, and Jerusalem shall dwell safely: and this is the name wherewith she shall be called, The LORD our righteousness.

Execute #6213 - a prim. Root; to do or make, in the broadest sense and widest application (as follows) - : accomplish, advance, bring forth, appoint......

Judgement #4941 from #8199; prop. a verdict (favorable or unfavorable) pronounced judicially, espec. a sentence or formal decree (human or [partic.] divine law, individually or collectively), including the act, the place, the suit, the crime, and the penalty.....

#8199 - a prim. root; to judge, i.e. pronounce sentence (for or against); by impl. to vindicate or punish.

Righteousness #6666 from 6663 - rightness.....

#6663 - a prim. root; to be (caust. make) right (in a moral or forensic sense), - cleanse, clear self, (be, do) just (ice, ify, ify self), (be, turn to) righteousness.

JER 4:1,2 If thou wilt return, O Israel, saith the LORD, return unto me: and if thou wilt put away thine abominations out of my sight, then shalt thou not remove. [2] And thou shalt swear, The LORD liveth, in truth, in judgment, and in righteousness; and the nations shall bless themselves in him, and in him shall they glory.

ISA 33:5,6 The LORD is exalted; for he dwelleth on high: he hath filled Zion with judgment and righteousness. [6] And wisdom and knowledge shall be the stability of thy times, and strength of salvation: the fear of the LORD is his treasure.

ISA 32:16 Then judgment shall dwell in the wilderness, and righteousness remain in the fruitful field.

ISA 1:25-27 And I will turn my hand upon thee, and purely purge away thy dross, and take away all thy tin: [26] And I will restore thy judges as at the first, and thy counsellors as at the beginning: afterward thou shalt be called, The city of righteousness, the faithful city. [27] Zion shall be redeemed with judgment, and her converts with righteousness.

JER 9:24 But let him that glorieth glory in this, that he understandeth and knoweth me, that I am the LORD which exercise livingkindness, judgment, and righteousness in the earth: for in these things I delight, saith the LORD.

Fountain

JER:17:13,14 O LORD, the hope of Israel, all that forsake thee shall be ashamed, and they that depart from me shall be written in the earth, because they have forsaken the LORD, the fountain of living waters. [14] Heal me, O LORD, and I shall be healed; save me, and I shall be saved: for thou art my praise.

ZEC 13:1,2 In that day there shall be a fountain opened to the house of David and to the inhabitants of Jerusalem for sin and for uncleanness. [2] And it shall come to pass in that day, saith the LORD of hosts, that I will cut off the names of the idols out of the land, and they shall no more be remembered: and also I will cause the prophets and the unclean spirit to pass out of the land.

Fountain - There are 5 words used for fountain in the OT. 4 pertain to water specifically. The 5th word used in Zech. is different.

Zech 13:1 - fountain #4726 from 6979- something dug, i.e. a (gen.) source (of water, even when naturally flowing; also of tears, blood; fig. (happiness, wisdom, progeny) fountain, issue, spring, well

#6979 - a prim. root: to trench; by impl. to throw forth; also (denom. from 7023) to wall up, whether lit. (to build a wall) or fig. (to estop) break down, cast out, destroy, dig.

Note: to build up a wall - the wall 144 cubits of the temple, Nehemiah study to break down a wall: Eze. 13:11

EZE 13:11 Say unto them which daub it with untempered mortar, that it shall fall: there shall be an overflowing shower; and ye, O great hailstones, shall fall; and a stormy wind shall rend it.

Wall in EZE. 13:11 is #7023 from 6979 (as built in a trench)....

Webster's New World Dictionary - Estop- to stop with tow, cram 1. originally, to stop up. 2. to stop, obstruct: prevent, bar 3. in law - to bar or prevent by estoppel.

Estoppel - in law - the prevention of a person from making an affirmation or denial because it is contrary to a previous affirmation or denial that has been made.

ISA 28:2 Behold, the Lord hath a mighty and strong one, which as a tempest of hail and a destroying storm, as a flood of mighty waters overflowing, shall cast down to the earth with the hand.

ISA 28:17,18 Judgment also will I lay to the line, and righteousness to the plummet: and the hail shall sweep away the refuge of lies, and the waters shall overflow the hiding place. [18] And your covenant with death shall be disannulled, and your agreement with hell shall not stand; when the overflowing scourge shall pass through, then ye shall be trodden down by it.

Overflowing #7857 a prim. root - to gush; by impl to inundate, cleanse; by anal. to gallop, conquer: - drown, (over) flow, (over) whelm, rinse, run (thoroughly) wash (away).

Scourge #7885 from 7751; an oar; also (comp. 7752) a scourge (fig.): oar, scourge

#7752 from 7751; a lash (lit. or fig.): - scourge, whip

#7751 shoot; a prim. root, prop. to push fourth. to lash, i.e. (the sea with oars).....

Shower #1653 from 1652 - to shower, rain, shower

#1652 - to shower violently: - (caust. to rain).

Hail #1259 - Hail, hailstones.

ISA 4:4 When the Lord shall have washed away the filth of the daughters of Zion, and shall have purged the blood of Jerusalem from the midst thereof by the spirit of judgment, and by the spirit of burning.

Rev. 14:5 And in their mouth was found no guile: for they are without fault before the throne of God.

Guile #1388 prob. meaning to decoy; a trick (bait) i.e. fig. - wile; craft, deceit, guile, subtility.

Fault #299 - unblemished, without blame....

Zeph. 3:13 The remnant of Israel shall not do iniquity, nor speak lies; neither shall a deceitful tongue be found in their mouth: for they shall feed and lie down, and none shall make them afraid.

2 Cor. 4:1,2 Therefore seeing we have this ministry, as we have received mercy, we faint not; [2] But have renounced the hidden things of dishonesty, not walking in craftiness,

nor handling the word of God deceitfully; but by manifestation of the truth commending ourselves to every man's conscience in the sight of God.

1 John 4:6 We are of God: he that knoweth God heareth us; he that is not of God heareth not us. Hereby know we the spirit of truth, and the spirit of error.

Error - #4106 fem. of 4108 (as abstrac.) fraudulence; subj. a straying from orthodoxy or piety, deceit, to deceive, delusion, error

2 Peter 2:18,19 These are wells without water, clouds that are carried with a tempest; to whom the mist of darkness is reserved for ever. [18] For when they speak great swelling words of vanity, they allure through the lusts of the flesh, through much wantonness, those that were clean escaped from them who live in error. [19] While they promise them liberty, they themselves are the servants of corruption: for of whom a man is overcome, of the same is he brought in bondage.

James 5:19 Brethren, if any of you do err from the truth, and one convert him; [20] Let him know, that he which converteth the sinner from the error of his way shall save a soul from death, and shall hide a multitude of sins.

Err #4105 from 4106 - (to roam) from safety, truth or virtue); go astray, deceive, err, seduce, wander, be out of the way.

Convert #1994 from 1909 + 4762; to revert (lit. fig. or mor.), come (go) again, convert, return (about, again).
